Abstract: An infographic is presented outlining the steps a chiropractic must take to become a registered chiropractor under the National Law in Australia.

Upon graduation in Australia there is no 'National Board' exam to sit, and no state-based exams. Under the National Law chiropractors apply for national registration and have freedom of movement across state borders.

Naturally there is a 'process' for new graduates to follow, bearing in mind that all students have held *National Registration* as a *Student of Chiropractic* with the *Chiropractic Board of Australia* for all years since commencing their program of study.

Here I present an infographic designed to provide a visual timeline of the steps involved; from '*university completion*' to '*practice commencement*' as a registered Chiropractor in Australia.
